"Effect of Motomed Gracile on Function Lower Limbs in Children with Spastic Cerebral Palsy"

Objective: To observe the effect of MOTOmed Gracile on spastic cerebral palsy.

48 cerebral palsy children were divided into two groups: invention Methods:

> group (n=24) and control group (n=24). The children in the control group accepted comprehensive rehabilitation, while the children in the intervention group were trained with Motomed Gracile in addition. They were evaluated with Asworth Assessment and manual muscle testing

(MMT) 6 months after treatment.

Results: The scores of intervention group improved more significantly than those

in control group (P0.05)

Conclusion: MOTOmed Gracile can facilitate the recovery of children with spastic

cerebral palsy.
